## WASPS Gymnastic KS2 Competition Rules

- 1. The competition is comprised of 5 stages: stage 1 being beginner level and stage 5 advanced. Gymnasts do not have to enter the same stage for floor and vault, but rather the stages that best reflect their level of skill.
- 2. Each school can enter up to 30 children in total across all stages. This can be any combination of boys and girls.
- 3. There is no limit to the number of children that can be entered at each stage. However, each child can only enter one stage for floor and vault.
- 4. Gymnasts who compete at an advanced club level outside of school should compete in stage 5.
- 5. If a child has won a medal at any stage, in floor or vault, they must progress to the next level (except stage 5, which is an open category).
- 6. If a child scores 9.00 or above in any vault stage, they must progress to the next level (except stage 5).
- 7. If a child scores 8.5 or above in any floor stage they must progress to the next level (except stage 5).
- 8. Schools may enter one group of stage 1 children for the group routines.
- 9. Please ensure there are sufficient staff/adults accompanying your school at the event. The suggested ratio is 1:10.
- 10.All entries should be submitted by the date stipulated.
- 11.All decisions made by judges and organisers are final.
- 12.Points will be awarded in the following way: 3 points for gold, 2 points for silver and 1 point for bronze. The school with the highest amount of points will be City Champions.

There may be some flexibility surrounding how many gymnasts can enter the competition. Please contact the organiser if you have additional gymnasts that you would like to enter. The aim is to include as many gymnasts as possible but the decision is dependent on overall entry numbers.
